I am apalled that a government agency such as the Department of Energy has already sold radioactive waste materials to scrap dealers to be used in consumer products without warning labels on those products. Untold numbers of consumers could be exposed to radiation through their braces, silverweare, metal baby products, etc.

I understand that the Nuclear Regulatory Commission is preparing to set standards to legalize the large-scale release of these contaminated materials for recycling.
