SUBJECT: Statement of Intent, License No. SUB 1435

1. As Commander of U.S. Army Jefferson Proving Ground, Madison, Indiana, I exercise the authority to request funding for decommissioning of all operations within my activity. The estimated funding requirement associated with decommissioning of my activity is \$17,462,500. This includes the soft-target impact area, as well as a 25 percent contingency factor. It is intended, subject to availability, that funding will be available sufficiently in advance of decommissioning to prevent delay of required actions.

2. A copy of my assumption of command letter is enclosed as evidence that I am authorized to represent the U.S. Army Jefferson Proving Ground in this transaction.

**DECOMMISSIONING FUNDING PLAN
FOR
NRC SOURCE MATERIAL
LICENSE NO. SUB 1435**

1. The cost estimate is based on the total area of land to be decontaminated, 1280 acres, located in the south-central portion of Jefferson Proving Ground. Depleted uranium projectiles were fired into the area from three firing positions heavily contaminating an estimated 80 acres to a depth of 6 feet. Projectiles which ricocheted may be in an area of 1200 acres near the surface. Costs for cleaning the heavily contaminated area is \$79,000 per acre. Near the surface, the clean-up cost is \$49,000 per acre. The cost of storage, disposal, shipment, etc., is an additional 10 percent. Thus:

2. Funds for decommissioning will be obtained when necessary.

3. Records of information important to safe and effective decommission shall be maintained at the Jefferson Proving Ground Environmental Management Office until this license is terminated by the Commission.
