CASK SYSTEM

I am requesting that the Division of Industrial and Medical Nuclear Safety (IMNS) complete the actions necessary to revise 10 CFR 72.214 (list of approved spent fuel storage cask designs) to add Amendment No. 3 to Certificate of Compliance (CoC) No. 1004 for the Transnuclear West, Inc. (TN West) NUHOMS®-24P and -52B cask systems. On July 26, 1999, TN West submitted an application and associated Safety Analysis Report (SAR) to amend CoC No. 1004 to permit the storage of burnable poison rod assemblies in the NUHOMS® cask system. Proposed language revising 10 CFR 72.214 and Federal Register notice supporting information are attached.

We are reviewing the associated SAR in accordance with 10 CFR 72.246 and have concluded that issuance of Amendment No. 3 is warranted. We will provide a proposed Amendment No. 3 to CoC No. 1004 and preliminary Safety Evaluation Report to IMNS by March 15, 2000, for your inclusion in the proposed rule package. I am requesting that this amendment be issued via the direct final rulemaking process. The schedule for this rulemaking should be consistent with the generic schedule for CoC rulemakings previously discussed between our staffs.
