The Nuclear Regulatory Commission's Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards has scheduled meetings of several of its subcommittees September 22-24 in Rockville, Maryland.

The subcommittee on materials and metallurgy will meet on September 22 at 1:00 p.m. to review the NRC staff's proposed revision to 10 CFR 50.55a of the Commission's regulations, entitled, "Codes and standards," which eliminates the requirement to update in-service inspection and testing programs every 120 months.

The subcommittees on reliability and probabilistic risk assessment and on regulatory policies and practices will hold a joint meeting September 23-24. It will review proposed revisions to the NRC's probabilistic risk assessment implementation plan, and the proposed rulemaking plan for development of risk-informed revisions to Part 50 of the Commission's regulations. The meeting will begin at 1:00 p.m. on September 23, and at 8:30 a.m. on September 24. The subcommittee on plant license renewal will meet on September 23 to review the status of the generic aging lessons-learned program, the license renewal process and the proposed format of renewal applications.
