SUBJECT: NRC DOCUMENTS - HISTORICAL AND CURRENT

As we near the landmark of completing the placement of the collections of NRC documents on 48X microfiche, we want to express our appreciation, on behalf of NRC, for your decision to retain the collections in your libraries. Of the 73 former Local Public Document Rooms that held the comprehensive microfiche collections, 54 elected to retain them; the other 19 collections are being moved into libraries of the United States Government Printing Office/Federal Depository Library Program (GPO/FDLP), with the cooperation and support of that agency. Twenty-eight of the retaining libraries are also members of FDLP.

The microfiche collections were frozen effective with NRC documents processed 31 October 1999. Access to these historical documents will continue to be via the Bibliographic Retrieval System (BRS) and the Nuclear Documents System (NUDOCS) until the records from these systems are entered into the public legacy library of the new Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS).

Beginning 1 November, 1999, NRC documents have been entered into ADAMS and are no longer routinely being produced in paper or microfiche. Thus, access to current NRC publicly available documents requires utilization of ADAMS, which has a Windows-based approach and may be reached via the NRC Web site (<http://www.nrc.gov/>), Public Electronic Reading Room or PERR (bottom of the first screen). The PERR site contains information about ADAMS, instructions for getting started, and an ADAMS Users' Guide. For your information, we enclose copies of the Users' Guide, information about using ADAMS with a firewall, and details about CITRIX, the software for accessing ADAMS. Additional information of interest to and concerning current holders of NRC microfiche collections will be posted shortly at the following url: <http://www.NRC.gov/NRC/public.html>. If you wish to be notified when this URL is updated, please send us your e-mail address.

The librarians of the NRC Public Document Room (PDR) are available to give support to librarians and public end users in accessing both historical and current (ADAMS) documents. The PDR provides the same types of service as it has in the past: advising users; performing searches, especially for infrequent users; managing a contract for reproducing documents from

paper, microfiche, and electronic formats; and training the public in ADAMS. We encourage you to contact the PDR librarians for any information or assistance you may need. As appropriate, they will liaison with NRC information technology (IT) staff in regard to ADAMS access and other IT issues. They may be reached at 1-800-397-4209 or 202-634-3273 (8:30 am to 4:15 pm, eastern time, Monday through Friday, except for Federal holidays), e-mail ([pdr@nrc.gov](mailto:pdr@nrc.gov)), fax (202-734-3343), or U. S. Mail (U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Public Document Room, LL-6, Washington, DC 20005).

If you are located in the Washington, DC area or have occasion to visit here, you are cordially invited to contact the PDR librarians to schedule an ADAMS training session. NRC is also exploring the option of giving ADAMS training in other locations, without cost to the participants, in cooperation with the GPO/FDLP. Please contact us if you would like to attend ADAMS training at or near your library. Priority would be given to situations of heightened community interest in a nuclear facility, such as occurs, for example, in re-licensing or decommissioning (a list of sites in the process of or scheduled for re-licensing is enclosed).

Teresa Linton will be making a presentation at the FDLP Interagency Depository Seminar in June in the Washington, DC vicinity. If you or a member of your staff will be attending, please identify yourself to her, and at your option, arrange for ADAMS training before or after the Seminar. PDR librarians will also be participating in the FDLP Conference in October, 2000.
