As per your request, this letter is being forwarded to outline future precautions to prevent further incidents of theft of nuclear gauges. This particular gauge was stolen just prior to daylight on November 10, 1999. The police report shows November 11, 1999. We no longer will park outside of the fenced compound without someone being in the vehicle at all times to guard the gauge. Also no stops will be made in route to or from jobsites where the gauge will be out of sight of the technician at any time, even though the gauges will be locked as well as the type "A" packages as was the case in this incident. Locks and or cables alone have been proven not to be effective against theft. Therefore, we will observe the gauges 100% of the time they are out of the building.
