

SECY-R 143 - AMENDMENT TO 10 CFR 50 - GENERAL DESIGN CRITERIA FOR NUCLEAR  
POWER PLANTS

SECY:RDL

At Regulatory Meeting 296 on February 8, 1971 the Commission:

- a. Approved publication in effective form of the amendment to 10 CFR Part 50 which would add an Appendix "A" to SECY-R 143, "General Design Criteria for Nuclear Power Plants" establishing minimum requirements for water-cooled nuclear power plants similar in design and location to plants for which construction permits have been previously issued by the Commission and providing guidance to the applicants for construction permits for establishing the principal design criteria for other types of nuclear power plants;
- b. Requested submission of draft legislation on early site hearings be expedited;
- c. Requested a Commission discussion with the ACRS on the effects of pressure vessel failures be scheduled;
- d. Noted that the amendment to 10 CFR Part 50 set forth in Appendix "A" to SECY-R 143 will be published in the Federal Register to be effective 90 days after publication;
- e. Noted that the Joint Committee on Atomic Energy will be informed by letter such as Appendix "C" to SECY-R 143; and
- f. Noted that a public announcement such as Appendix "D" to SECY-R 143 will be issued when the amendment is filed with the Federal Register.

The Director of Regulation has directed you to take the appropriate action. It is our understanding that your office will prepare the correspondence to the JCAE. Copies of this letter should be provided the Secretariat.


