License Transfer Amendment - Schedule Update

Gentlemen:

On November 5, 1999, GPU Nuclear, Inc. and AmerGen Energy Company, LLC submitted an "Application for Order and Conforming Administrative Amendments for License Transfer" for Oyster Creek. In that application, the parties committed to keep the NRC informed of any significant changes in the status of other required approvals or other developments that have an impact on the requested schedule for approval of the license transfer.

This letter is to inform you of the following review schedule recently established by the NJBPU.

March 1, 2000 – Deadline for the parties including the BPU staff and the state's ratepayer advocate to submit to GPU requests for further information.

March 15, 2000 – Deadline for GPU to respond to the information requests.

March 28, 2000 – The BPU will hold a "legislative type" hearing.

April 11, 2000 – All written comments from the parties regarding the application are due.

April 18, 2000 – Replies to written comments are due and the public hearing record will be officially closed.



Following the reviews, the board will vote at a public meeting, whether or not to approve the sale of the plant.


