EMERGENCY MITIGATION FUNCTIONS WHILE IN A SHUTDOWN
CONDITION

The purpose of this letter is to respond to your request to document the revised schedule date that Indiana Michigan Power Company (I&M) will provide a response to GL 98-02. On May 28, 1998, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission issued GL 98-02. The staff requested an assessment of the issues within 180 days, and if necessary, provide a response to the staff as prescribed in the GL.

A revised date was discussed with the staff's project manager in a telephone conversation on March 29, 2000. It was agreed that I&M will respond to GL 98-02 by August 1, 2000.
