

*Reference: PLA-5135, R. G. Byram to USNRC, "Proposed Amendment No. 229 to License NPF-14 and Proposed Amendment No. 192 to License NPF-22: Proposed License Transfer and Conforming License Amendments PP&L, Inc. Realignment," dated December 15, 1999.*

The purpose of this letter is to provide updated information regarding our Application filed pursuant to 10 C.F.R. §50.80 requesting consent to the transfer of facility operating licenses Nos. NPF-14 and NPF-22 for the Susquehanna Steam Electric Station (Susquehanna SES) Units 1 and 2. In a letter dated February 7, 2000, we provided you with supplemental information regarding changes in a number of officers discussed in our initial application.

Confirming our previous conversations, the names of certain of the companies referenced in the Application changed effective February 14, 2000. The name of PP&L Resources, Inc. changed to PPL Corporation, PP&L, Inc. changed to PPL Electric Utilities Corporation and PP&L EnergyPlus Co., LLC changed to PPL EnergyPlus, LLC. Names of other companies mentioned in the Application have changed but these are not material. The names of PPL Generation, LLC and PPL Susquehanna, LLC are not changing.

We believe the time required to process a license amendment to reflect the change in the name of the current licensee would likely cause such an amendment to be approved after the transfer request in this Application is determined. Therefore, we do not feel a license amendment to reflect the change from PP&L, Inc. to PPL Electric Utilities Corporation is warranted.


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There has been one additional change in the officers of PPL Corporation and PPL Electric Utilities Corporation. Terry H. Hunt, senior vice president-strategic planning resigned effective March 10, 2000.

The above updated information is being submitted in support of our 10 C.F.R. §50.80 Application. It alters neither the physical amendments to the operating licenses nor the No Significant Hazards Considerations provided with the Application.
