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NRC SUBCOMMITTEE ON MEDICAL USES OF NUCLEAR MATERIAL TO MEET IN ROCKVILLE

A subcommittee of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's Advisory Committee on Medical Uses of Isotopes will meet September 27 through 29 in Rockville, Maryland.

The meeting, which is open to the public, will be held at Two White Flint North, 11545 Rockville Pike, Room T2B1 and will begin at 8 a.m. each day.

Purpose of the meeting is to discuss draft licensing guidance currently under development by the NRC staff for certain medical uses of nuclear materials. The proposed guidance is scheduled to be published for public comment in early 1996. The subcommittee does not plan to accept comments from members of the public during the September meeting because of the amount of material to be discussed in a relatively short timeframe.
