NRC LICENSING BOARD TO HOLD PREHEARING CONFERENCE IN RIVER BEND PROCEEDING

The presiding Atomic Safety and Licensing Board has scheduled a prehearing conference on September 15 in Bethesda, Maryland in the Nuclear Regulatory Commission proceeding involving a change in ownership of Gulf States Utilities (GSU), the operator of the River Bend nuclear station near St. Francesville, Louisiana.

The conference will begin at 9:00 a.m. in the Licensing Board's Fifth Floor Hearing Room, 4350 East West Highway.

Under a proposed amendment to its operating license, GSU, which owns a 70 percent undivided interest in River Bend, would become a wholly owned subsidiary company of Entergy Corporation. Cajun Electric Power Cooperative has filed a petition to intervene and request for a hearing on the proposed amendment.

The purpose of the conference is to hear argument on the petition to intervene and to schedule any additional actions that may be appropriate.
