NRC TO SPONSOR WORKSHOP FOR STATE OFFICIALS ON CLEANUP OF CONTAMINATED SITES

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission will sponsor a national workshop for state officials in Potomac, Maryland, on March 23 to discuss issues relating to the cleanup of radiologically contaminated sites.

Participating with the NRC will be Radiation Control Program Directors from the 29 NRC Agreement States, which regulate most uses of nuclear material in their states, other than for nuclear power plants. The Agreement State Radiation Control Program Directors are the professional personnel in State government agencies who administer radiation control activities.

The workshop will be conducted at the U.S. Postal Service's William F. Bolgar Academy, 9600 Newbridge Drive, Potomac, from 8:00 a.m. until 5:45 p.m. It is open to the public for attendance and observation.
