NRC STAFF PLANS MEETING WITH STATE LIAISON OFFICERS

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff will meet in Rockville, Maryland, on September 29 and 30, with State Liaison Officers who are appointed by the Governors of the 50 states to provide a communication channel between the individual states and the NRC.

The meeting will be open to public observation and will be from 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. on September 29 and 8:30 a.m. to 12 Noon on September 30. It will be held at the Holiday Inn Crowne Plaza located at 1750 Rockville Pike in Rockville.

Topics to be discussed during the day and one-half meeting include: decommissioning of contaminated sites, medical misadministrations of nuclear materials, low-level radioactive waste management, renewal of nuclear power plant operating licenses, high-level radioactive waste management, international nuclear activities, storage of spent nuclear fuel in dry-cask storage facilities, emergency planning and NRC/state relationships.
