Dear Mr. Lohaus;

In accordance with the Guidance for Use by Agreement States for Submitting Regulations for NRC Staff Review, I have enclosed a disk containing the latest proposed regulation amendments to the Louisiana Administrative Code, Title 33, Part XV, Radiation Protection (NE021 and NE022). Both items are Word 6.0/95 version. I have also enclosed a hard copy of our current Radiation Protection regulations for comparative purposes.

This rule package consists almost entirely of amendments that are required for purposes of compatibility (category A, B, or C). All of the amendments in this package should meet NRC compatibility criteria. Wherever possible, the editor inserted the exact wording of the 10 CFR rules into the amendment, and followed Federal Register guidelines regarding Agreement State compatibility.

Regulations requiring amendments were identified from SA-200, Compatibility Categories and Health and Safety Identification for NRC Regulations and Other Program Elements, and SA-201, Review of State Regulations.

- NE021-10 CFR part 71: Compatibility with the International Atomic Energy Agency, effective date April 1, 1999 (60 FR 50248)
- NE022 - Termination or Transfer of Licensed Activities: Recordkeeping Requirements, effective date June 17, 1999 (61 FR 24669)
