NRC'S ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON MEDICAL USES
OF ISOTOPES TO MEET NOVEMBER 17 AND 18 IN ROCKVILLE, MD.

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission's Advisory Committee on Medical Uses of Isotopes will hold its next regular meeting November 17 and 18 in Rockville, Maryland.

The meeting, which is open to the public, will begin at 8:00 a.m. on both days at Two White Flint North, Room T2B3, 11545 Rockville Pike.

Committee Chairman Barry Siegel will chair the meeting. Topics for discussion will involve medical uses of nuclear material licensed by the NRC and will include a progress report on a study of the medical use program by the National Academy of Science, a status report on NRC regulation changes in the medical area that are currently under consideration, and issues involving followup of patients after errors in the administration of nuclear materials.
