DR. SHIRLEY ANN JACKSON SWORN IN AS MEMBER OF NUCLEAR REGULATORY COMMISSION

Dr. Shirley Ann Jackson was sworn in this afternoon as a member of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission for a term that expires June 30, 1999.
