Dear Ms. Latner:

I am responding to your letter of February 25, 2000, to Chairman Meserve which has been forwarded to me for response. In your letter, you voice a concern about Oyster Creek Nuclear Generating Station (Oyster Creek) and the application for a license transfer from GPU Nuclear, Inc. to AmerGen. You also mention in your letter that you support the Nuclear Information and Resource Service (NIRS) petition to intervene in the Oyster Creek license transfer and the proposed sale of Oyster Creek from GPU Nuclear, Inc. to AmerGen. The NRC has received NIRS' January 5, 2000, petition which is currently with the Commission for consideration. The NRC will follow the applicable regulation, Subpart M, 10 CFR 2.1316, in processing the request for a hearing on the proposed license transfer application. The regulations do allow the NRC staff to proceed in its evaluation parallel to the Commission's consideration of a request for a hearing. The NRC staff is evaluating the license transfer application to determine if AmerGen is qualified to be the holder of the license, and if it is consistent with applicable laws, orders, and regulations.

We appreciate you bringing your concerns to the attention of the NRC. The NRC will continue to monitor the performance of Oyster Creek to ensure that public health and safety are adequately protected.
