Subject: Response to Regulatory Issue Summary 2000-04

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) requested in Reference 2 that power reactor licensees, on a voluntary basis, submit information pertaining to estimates of the number of licensing actions that will be submitted for NRC review in the remainder of fiscal year (FY) 2000 and FY 2001.

Based on recent past experience and current plans, Omaha Public Power District (OPPD) estimates that for the remainder of FY 2000, six (6) requests for amendment may be submitted and seven (7) relief requests will be submitted.

For FY 2001, OPPD estimates that six (6) requests for amendment and one (1) request for exemption or relief may be submitted.

Please note that supplements or additional information related to licensing actions already under NRC review are not included in the estimates provided above. Please contact me if you have any questions.
