NRC'S ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON MEDICAL USES
OF RADIOISOTOPES TO MEET NOVEMBER 1 AND 2 IN RESTON, VA

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission's Advisory Committee on Medical Uses of Isotopes has scheduled a meeting November 1 and 2 in Reston, Virginia.
