MEMORANDUM AND ORDER (Schedules for Proceeding)

On Tuesday, April 18, 2000, the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board for this 10 C.F.R. Part 2, Subpart K spent-fuel-pool proceeding conducted a telephone conference call for the purpose of establishing future schedules.

Participating, in addition to the three Licensing Board members, were David A. Repka, Esq., counsel for Northeast Nuclear Energy Company, Licensee; Nancy Burton, Esq., counsel for Connecticut Coalition Against Millstone (CCAM) and Long Island Coalition Against Millstone (CAM), Intervenors; and Anne Hodgdon, Esq., Brooke D. Poole, Esq., and Mr. Victor Nerses, Project Manager, for the NRC Staff. Lee S. Dewey, Esq., Chief Counsel of the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board Panel, was also present.

After discussion with all parties, and in accordance with requirements set forth at 10 C.F.R. § 2.1113, the Licensing Board established the following schedule, which is premised on completion of discovery by May 30, 2000, the date currently effective:

- 1. Filing of parties' written summaries: Friday, June 30, 2000.
- Oral argument: Wednesday, July 19, 2000 and, to the extent necessary, Thursday, July 20, 2000.

Oral argument will be held in the New London,

Connecticut area, at a time and location to be announced.

Oral argument is expected to occupy one day but, as

necessary, could be extended to the following morning. On

Thursday, July 20, 2000, following oral argument or, if oral

argument has been completed, at the start of the day, the

Board will hear oral limited appearance statements, as

authorized by 10 C.F.R. §§ 2.1117 and 2.715(a). After such

statements, the Board requests the Licensee to provide a

site tour (if time permits) for members of the Licensing

Board and all parties who wish to participate.

At the conclusion of the conference call, the Licensee advised that it was submitting an amendment to its proposal currently under review in this proceeding, adding a requirement that boron in the spent fuel pool be monitored at least weekly. This amendment may have an effect on contention 5 and possibly contention 4. The Board urged the parties to attempt to reach agreement on those two

contentions, and the parties continued the conference call without the Board members to attempt to achieve that goal, as well as to discuss discovery and other matters.
