

Dear Nuclear Regulatory Commissioners:

Please ensure the Nuclear Regulatory Commission examines the antitrust issues involved in British Energy's attempts to buy 20 U.S. nuclear power plants through its subsidiary, Amergen. I am uncomfortable with a single private company controlling a large percentage of our country's nuclear power plants.

I believe that our electrical generation should all remain owned by U.S. Companies. Hence no foreign owned company should own any nuclear generation plants in the U.S..

Public Hearings need to be held on the issue of nuclear energy generating plants run by foreign owned companies. These hearings must be called for before the Nuclear Regulatory Commission sells these companies to Amergen.

I hope you will insist that these hearings be held soon.
