SUBJECT: SECY-91-262 - RESOLUTION OF SELECTED TECHNICAL AND SEVERE ACCIDENT ISSUES FOR EVOLUTIONARY LIGHT WATER REACTOR (LWR) DESIGNS

The Commission (with all Commissioners agreeing) has approved the staff's recommendation to proceed with design-specific rulemakings through individual design certifications to resolve selected technical and severe accident issues for the ABWR and ABB/CE System 80+ designs. Additionally, the staff should proceed with generic rulemaking as quickly as possible where appropriate for evolutionary and passive designs.

2) Would this process be limited to severe accident issues, or would it logically need to be applied to all issues where the agency proposes going beyond existing regulatory requirements?
