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NOTE TO EDITORS:

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission's Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards has scheduled a meeting of its subcommittee on thermal-hydraulic phenomena on February 23 in Rockville, Maryland.

The subcommittee will continue its review of the application of Westinghouse Electric Company's WCOBRA/TRAC best-estimate, large-break, loss-of-coolant-accident computer code to Westinghouse plants with upper plenum injection.

The subcommittee will meet at 8:30 a.m. until the conclusion of business, in Room T-2B1 of the agency's Two White Flint North Building at 11545 Rockville Pike.

Other aspects of the meeting, including an opportunity for public comment, will be described in a forthcoming edition of the Federal Register.

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
