The Nuclear Regulatory Commission's Advisory Committee on the Medical Uses of Isotopes has scheduled meetings March 24-25 in Rockville, Maryland.

The committee will discuss revisions to the proposed rule on the medical use of byproduct material, the analysis of comments on the draft rule, and issues regarding prostate implant therapy.
