WEBER RECEIVES 'EXEMPLARY ACHIEVEMENT' AWARD

Michael F. Weber, a branch chief at the Nuclear Regulatory Commission, has received the 1996 William A. Jump Award for Exemplary Achievement in Public Administration, given annually for outstanding performance in the Federal service.

He was selected for this year's award by the William A.
