Response to Regulatory Issue Summary 2000-04
Operating Reactor Licensing Action Estimates

Ladies and Gentlemen:

On March 16, 2000, the NRC issued Regulatory Issue Summary 2000-04, "Operating Reactor Licensing Action Estimates," which requested that licensees submit information pertaining to estimates of the number of licensing actions that will be submitted for NRC review for the remainder of Fiscal Year (FY) 2000 and for FY 2001. With regard to the Joseph M. Farley Nuclear Plant, Southern Nuclear Operating Company estimates that eight (8) submittals will be made during the remainder of FY 2000 and that nine (9) submittals will be made during FY 2001. It is not anticipated that any of the planned submittals will generate a complex review.

This estimate does not constitute a formal NRC commitment and may change due to shifts in priority and personnel availability.
