I am writing you in support of an application recently filed by Southern Nuclear Operating Company (SNC) requesting the operating terms for Plant Hatch Units 1 and 2 be extended for an additional twenty years.

Plant Hatch has been a vital part of the economy of Appling County and the surrounding area since its construction in the early seventies. Plant Hatch accounts for well over 50 percent of our tax base that enables our county to provide better services, have better facilities, and enjoy lower property tax rates than our neighboring counties.
