EVENT TEXT

OFFSITE NOTIFICATION REGARDING THE DISCOVERY OF A DEAD FLORIDA CROCODILE (AN ENDANGERED SPECIES) IN THE SITE'S COOLING CANAL SYSTEM

At 1320 on 12/07/99, the Land Utilization Group notified the control room of the discovery of a dead crocodile in the site's cooling canal system. It is currently believed that the dead crocodile lost a fight with a larger crocodile.

The licensee notified the NRC resident inspector. In accordance with an Environmental Permit, the licensee also plans to notify the Florida Game and Freshwater Fish Commission.

OFFSITE NOTIFICATION OF DEAD CROCODILE IN COOLING CANAL

Plant management was notified by land utilization personnel that a deceased 4.5-foot long American crocodile was found yesterday (6/6/99) in the suction of one of the cooling canal skimmer pumps. An autopsy was performed, but the cause of death could not be determined. FPL is notifying state and local authorities and is planning a news release to the press. No further actions are planned.

The NRC resident inspector has been notified by the licensee.
