Annual Environmental Protection Plan Report For the 1999 Calendar Year Pursuant to Appendix B to Facility Licenses Indian Point Unit Nos. 1, 2, and 3

Subsection 5.4.1 of Appendix B to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission Facility Operating Licenses for Indian Point Units 1, 2, (issued April 24, 1981) and 3 (issued May 26, 1981), requires that an annual Environmental Protection Plan Report (the "Report") describing implementation of the facilities' Environmental Protection Plan (the "EPP") for the previous year be submitted to the NRC prior to May 1 of each year. This Report is for the 1999 calendar year.

Subsection 5.4.1 of Appendix B specifies that the Report shall include summaries and analyses of the results of any EPP activities (environmental monitoring) required by Subsection 4.2 of the EPP for the reporting period.
