We plan to develop unreliability indicators, in accordance with our formal performance indicator change process, for the systems whose unavailability is currently measured in our revised reactor oversight process. Predicated on our understanding that INPO will continue to provide component reliability information for the risk-important maintenance rule systems to the Equipment Performance and Information Exchange system, we accept this change to our previous agreement.
