Gentlemen:

Enclosed are the original and three copies each of Revision 19, Change 3 of the Waterford 3 Physical Security Plan (Enclosure 1), Revision 6, Change 4 of the Waterford 3 Safeguards Contingency Plan (Enclosure 2) and Revision 6, Change 3 of the Security Training and Qualification Plan (Enclosure 3), which are submitted in accordance with 10CFR50.54(p). The plan changes were approved and implemented on March 28, 2000 and March 29, 2000. This submittal is provided under affidavit per requirements of 10CFR50.

The Waterford 3 Plant Operations Review Committee has concluded that the changes to the Waterford 3 Physical Security Plan, Safeguards Contingency Plan and Security Training and Qualification Plan do not constitute a decrease in the safeguards effectiveness of the plans. The major change includes the incorporation of the use of long rifles as a contingency weapon.

Enclosures 1 and 2 contain safeguards information as defined by 10CFR73.21 and its disclosure to unauthorized individuals is prohibited by Section 147 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended. Enclosure 3 includes proprietary information. It is





These documents were reviewed in accordance with applicable regulations, and describe Waterford 3 Plant Security practices which are considered to be information customarily held in confidence by Entergy Operations, Inc. and is being submitted to the Commission in confidence.
