Although MTI has not filed Preliminary Objections in the eminent domain matter, MTI may continue to have rights to the property for up to three years. (The condemnee retains the right of possession until it receives just compensation or a written offer of just compensation from Condemnor. Pa. Stat. Ann. tit. 26 § 1-407(a) (In this matter, no written offer of just compensation has been made); If condemnor relinquishes condemnation within one year, title may revert back to condemnee. Pa. Stat. Ann. tit. 26 § 1-408; If condemnor abandons project, in certain conditions condemnee retains a right of first refusal for up to three years. Pa. Stat. Ann. tit. 26 § 1-410.) As a purchase money lender, Jobert's rights flow through MTI's in the eminent domain action.
