Pursuant to 10 CFR 50.71(b), Florida Power Corporation (FPC) hereby submits its annual financial report (Florida Progress Corporation 1999 Annual Report) and the annual financial reports for eight (8) of the ten (10) participating co-owners of the Crystal River Unit 3 (CR-3) Nuclear Station. Due to delays in printing production, annual financial reports for the City of Bushnell and the City of Ocala are not yet available. These outstanding annual financial reports will be submitted to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission by July 31, 2000.

By letter dated October 1, 1999, the NRC issued Amendment No. 189 approving the transfer of the license for CR-3, to the extent it was held by the City of Tallahassee, to FPC. The license transfer was completed on October 1, 1999. As such, the City of Tallahassee is no longer a co-owner of CR-3 and after this year, will no longer be submitting their annual financial report.
