Dear Mr. Corletti:

In a letter to Mr. Collins, dated May 4, 2000, Westinghouse requested the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) to proceed with the phase one assessment of the NRC's pre-application review of the AP1000 standard plant design. The purpose of the phase one assessment, as agreed in our meeting on April 27, 2000, is to identify the review assumptions, questions, and policy issues that the NRC staff will evaluate during the phase two (feasibility) review and to estimate the NRC resources that will be needed to perform the feasibility review. The NRC will charge Westinghouse a fee, under 10 CFR Part 170, for its effort on the phase one assessment.

It is requested that Westinghouse provide its assessment of the issues that need to be evaluated by the NRC staff during the feasibility review by May 31, 2000. The NRC staff will meet with Westinghouse on June 5, 2000 to discuss these issues. Subsequently, the staff will send a letter to Westinghouse that identifies the issues to be evaluated in phase two, the information that the NRC will need to receive from Westinghouse to perform this review, and an estimate of the cost and schedule for the phase two review. As discussed during our telephone conversation on May 10th, I expect to inform you of the results of our phase one assessment by July 14, 2000.
