#### NORTHEAST NUCLEAR ENERGY COMPANY'S SECOND SET OF INTERROGATORIES DIRECTED TO CONNECTICUT COALITION AGAINST MILLSTONE AND LONG ISLAND COALITION AGAINST MILLSTONE

By letter dated May 8, 2000, the Connecticut Coalition Against Millstone ("CCAM") and the Long Island Coalition Against Millstone ("CAM") (collectively, "Intervenors") identified Mr. James Plumb as a potential witness in this proceeding.
