NRC Request

In attachment 1, Page 3 of 5, to your April 10, 2000 letter regarding Change Request No. 60 to the SNEC Technical Specifications (TS), you indicated that TS 3.5.4 would be revised, in part, to specify that audits at the SNEC Facility would be conducted in accordance with "approved Quality Assurance Plan Procedures" in lieu of "GPU Nuclear Audit Program Procedures".

Please clarify whether the term "Quality Assurance Plan" as used in the proposed SNEC TS refers to GPU Nuclear Corporate Policy & Procedure Manual Number 1000-PLN-3000.05, "Saxton Nuclear Experimental Corporation Facility Decommissioning Quality Assurance Plan". Otherwise, please identify the decommissioning quality assurance plan or program description upon which the audit procedures required by SNEC TS 3.5.4 will be based following the sale of the Oyster Creek Nuclear Generating Station.


