In a letter dated May 10, 2000, we requested additional information concerning a Florida Power Corporation proposal to increase the licensed capacity for spent fuel assembly storage in the Crystal River Unit 3 spent fuel pool and revise the configuration for storage of fresh fuel. Due to an administrative error, a turnaround time of 30 days was indicated as agreed to by your staff for providing this information. The turnaround time agreed to by your staff was 45 days from receipt of the May 10, 2000, letter. We regret any inconvenience this error may have caused your staff.
