SUBJECT: CATEGORICAL EXCLUSION UNDER THE PROVISION  
OF 10 CFR 51.22(c)(11)

By application letter dated February 15, 2000, U.S. Army requested Material License No. SUB-1435 for its Jefferson Proving Ground (JPG) site in Indiana amended to: (1) authorize transfer of licensing responsibilities for the JPG site from the U.S. Army Test and Evaluation Command to the U.S. Army Soldier and Biological Chemical Command, (2) designate Ms. Joyce E. Kuykendall as the Radiation Safety Officer for the site, and (3) include the revised JPG Security Plan in the license.

These revisions meet the conditions that: (i) there is no significant change in the types, or significant increase in the amounts of any effluent that may be released offsite; (ii) there is no significant increase in individual or cumulative occupational radiation exposure; (iii) there is no significant construction impact; and (iv) there is no significant increase in the potential for, or consequences from radiological accidents.

NRC staff has reviewed these revisions and has concluded that they are acceptable, as they will not affect the public health and safety nor the environment. Therefore, in accordance with 10 CFR 51.22(c)(11), neither an environmental assessment nor an environmental impact statement is warranted for this action.
