Here is the Maine Response to the OMB requests outlined in SP-00-004. As we discussed on the phone, we do not keep records of how much time is actually spent on these issues, so these are only estimates.

In response to OMB Clearance 3150-0183, we submit the following information, regarding the documentation requirements of each listed aspect:

New Agreements State Programs: Not applicable

IMPEP participation: 16 hours/year

Questionnaire (IMPEP): 20 hours/questionnaire (once every 3 years)

Maintenance of

existing AS Program: Training: 3 hours/year

Procedures: 7 hours/year

Licensing: 300 hours/year

Inspections: 50 hours/year

Rulemaking: 240 hours/year

Total: 600 hours/year

In response to OMB Clearance 3150-0029, we submit the following information, regarding the one-time or as-needed requests for information:

As we discussed, only a small number of the requests are acted upon by this Agency. This is due in part to how applicable it may be for our program. In general we respond to about 5-6 of them a year. Depending on what the specific request is, the response can take anywhere from 2 hours on up to 30-40 hours per year. On average over the past 3 years, we have spent approximately 16 hours in the documentation in response to these one-time or as-needed requests from NRC.
