



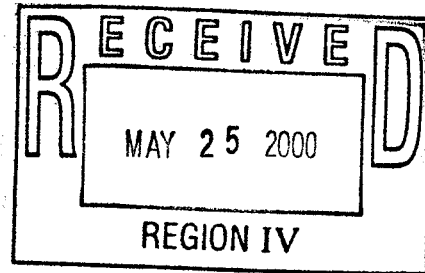

On May 30, 2000, in the NRC Region IV office, Entergy will present an overview of the efforts we are taking to improve the performance of Waterford 3 Security. The purpose of this letter is to formally submit our Security Improvement Plan (Attachment 1) prior to this meeting for your review.

The management team at Waterford 3 and senior Entergy management are committed to improving our performance in Security and restoring Waterford 3 to a position of excellence in the industry. The Security Improvement Plan presents goals, strategies, associated actions and performance indicators, and commits to firm, realistic dates for achieving every action. The plan supports both near-term and continuous improvement. Input to the Security Improvement Plan included information from Root Cause Analyses, Condition Reports, NRC inspections and evaluations, and self-assessment reports.

We are committed to fostering an environment that supports continuous improvement of our performance and the implementation of this improvement plan. Management fully supports efforts toward the pursuit of excellence in the Security Program with a vision of making it one of the premier Security programs in the region.

Success will be measured through the use of performance indicators to trend the performance of the organization throughout the implementation of this plan. We are determined to move to a state of excellence. We are dedicated and committed to initiatives and programs that will help us achieve top performance.

Actions
