SUBJECT: Application for Renewal of Special Nuclear Material License SNM-2500

Dear Mr. Hall,

In accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 72, General Electric Company submits a license renewal application for its Morris Operation, Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation (ISFSI) located at 7555 East Collins Road in Morris, Illinois. Included with this application is a revised Consolidated Safety Analysis Report, Applicant's Environmental Report, and 1999 Financial Statement. Revision 2 of the QA Plan was previously submitted for review. The Security Plan and Emergency Plan have been previously approved and remain unchanged.

Facilities described in this application are owned and operated by General Electric Company, a corporation under the laws of the State of Connecticut, with its principal place of business at Fairfield, CT. The facility is operated through the Company's GE Nuclear Energy Division with headquarters in San Jose, California and operations in Morris, Illinois.

GE is a broadly diversified corporation involved in research, design, manufacture, and marketing of products and services in several fields including industrial products, technical systems and materials, consumer products, and power systems. The latter activity includes nuclear systems, equipment, fuel and services.

The Company's experience in nuclear activities includes research and development of nuclear submarine prototype reactors, operation of the government's Hanford facilities for more than 17 years and development, design, manufacture and erection of boiling water reactors currently operating, or under construction, at electric power stations in the United States and throughout the world. The staff of GE Nuclear Energy (GENE) includes hundreds of scientists, engineers and technicians, representing one of the largest pools of nuclear knowledge and experience in the world.

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The Company has owned and operated Morris Operation since its construction under AEC Provisional Construction Permit No. CPCSF-3 issued in December, 1967 as a spent fuel reprocessing facility, and specifically as an ISFSI for the last 18 years under the current NRC License SNM-2500.

GE has determined that the application in this submittal is acceptable for ensuring that activities at the Morris Operation ISFSI are conducted without endangering the health and safety of the public, and are in compliance with the applicable regulations in 10 CFR 72. Also, approval of this application will not be inimical to the common defense and security, and the application does not involve any adverse environmental impact.

In accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR 72.16(c), 15 copies of this letter and its attachments are included, in addition to the signed original.
