Dear Ms. Overland:

On behalf of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff, I want to express our regret for any inconvenience that may have been caused by our failure to notify you of the NRC staff's approval of Northern States Power Company's (NSP's) application for transfers of operating authority to Nuclear Management Company, LLC, at the time that NSP was notified. As a result of this, the NRC staff is reviewing its procedures to ensure that, in the future, such situations do not recur and that all affected parties receive prompt notification of major staff actions such as this.

As you know, the Commissioners are currently considering the request for hearing and petition to intervene filed by you on February 28, 2000, as well as petitions filed by the North American Water Office and the Prairie Island Indian Community. Please recognize that, under the Commission's Rules of Practice in 10 CFR Part 2, Subpart M, the staff's action does not affect your hearing request.
