With this letter United Nuclear Corporation submits its quarterly analysis of reclamation costs as required in license condition No. 25 of our License SUA-1475 for the Church Rock site. This analysis is for the first quarter of 2000.

## FIRST QUARTER 2000 COSTS

The costs incurred for tailings reclamation in the first quarter of 2000 totaled \$48,881.00. Consistent with the Annual Surety Estimate all costs incurred in the first quarter 2000 were in the area of seepage cleanup actions.
