Dear Mr. Blind:

This letter updates our April 19, 2000, letter that provided time lines for various NRC activities. The updates primarily stem from changes to your projected dates for necessary submittals to the NRC.

On May 31, 2000, you informed the staff that you would be delaying submitting your condition monitoring and operational assessment until June 5, 2000. Further, your responses to the staff's requests for additional information dated March 14, and 24, 2000, and topics of discussion from the May 3, 2000, meeting will be submitted on June 9, 2000. We have revised the time line we sent you on April 19, 2000, to reflect this change. In addition, other updates have been made to reflect the current status. The revised time line is enclosed.

As we have previously stated, we will require adequate time to complete our steam generator condition review. Assuming the information submitted is of acceptable quality, we estimate 3 weeks to complete our review. Therefore, our revised estimated completion date for our safety evaluation is July 3, 2000.
