Operating Reactor Licensing Action Estimates

Consolidated Edison Company of New York (Con Edison) currently estimates that approximately five (5) licensing actions will be submitted to the NRC during the remainder of the 2000 NRC fiscal year and approximately ten (10) will be submitted during the 2001 NRC fiscal year. While most of these licensing actions will be requests for license amendment, Con Edison has initiated the process to accept bids from qualified entities to become the future owner/ operator of Indian Point Unit No. 1 and No. 2. The license transfer process, if it occurs, would begin no earlier than late in the latter part of this year. Additionally, Indian Point No. 2 anticipates transitioning to Improved Technical Specifications utilizing the format of NUREG- 1431, "Standard Technical Specifications for Westinghouse Plants." This submittal is projected to be in late 2001.

No new regulatory commitments are being made by Con Edison in this correspondence.
