⁽¹⁾ Wolf Creek considers this Generic Letter closed based on the commitments to continue to participate in the JOG MOV periodic verification program and the words in the April 4, 2000 letter indicating that the NRC staff concluded that Wolf Creek has established an acceptable program to verify periodically the design-basis capability of the safety-related MOVs at WCGS.

⁽²⁾ Wolf Creek considers this amendment as being implemented on 3/3/00 based on completing the drag testing of all accessible cells. A letter is being drafted to indicate implementation complete and will indicate that an offset handling tool modification is scheduled for after June 30, 2000. Because the offset handling tool is not a piece of permanent plant equipment, its fabrication is not a modification to the plant and is therefore not considered to be required for implementation.

⁽³⁾ Wolf Creek considers this item closed based on the December 13, 1999 letter indicating that because rulemaking (64 FR 51369) has become effective that allows licensees to use ASME Code Case N-513, relief from 10 CFR 50.55a to use Code Case N-513 at WCGS is not required. Additionally, on December 18, 1999, Revision 3 to the Technical Requirements Manual, revised TR 3.4.17, "Structural Integrity," to provide guidance on the use of Code Case N-513.
