By letter dated February 29, 2000, TXU Electric (the licensee) requested approval for use of ASME Code Case N-498-2 for Comanche Peak Steam Electric Station, Units 1 and 2. Based upon subsequent conversations with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff, the licensee submitted requests for relief from the ASME Code dated April 18 and April 19, 2000. By letter dated May 19, 2000, the licensee withdrew the request for approval for use of the subject code case and the requests for relief from the ASME Code. This completes all actions under TAC Nos. MA8454 and MA8455.
