3.0 WORKSCOPE

Task 6

The contractor shall revise the regulatory analysis, supporting statement, and environmental assessment, and provide the NRC with drafts and a final version of each document.

The regulatory analysis shall include a Paperwork Reduction Act Statement and a Regulatory Flexibility Act Statement. The document shall be prepared in accordance with the most recent guidance, i.e., "Regulatory Analysis Guidelines of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission," NUREG BR-0058, Revision 2.

The contractor shall also prepare drafts and a final response to the public comments NRC received in response to the proposed rule regarding the regulatory analysis, supporting statement, and environmental assessment.

The level of effort for this modification is 132 hours, increasing the total level of effort for Task Order 15 to 2,405 hours.

The contractor shall plan on local travel for 2 people for 2 trips to NRC Headquarters to participate in meetings with the NRC Technical Project Manager to discuss progress or to resolve problems related to this task order.
