**KOEBERG NUCLEAR POWER STATION: INVITATION TO ATTEND THE EMERGENCY EXERCISE: 19 JULY 2000**


As part of the regulatory control measures applied to nuclear installations in South Africa, the National Nuclear Regulatory periodically requires that emergency planning and preparedness arrangements be demonstrated by way of a large scale emergency exercise. Such exercises are conducted every one to two years and the next one is scheduled to take place on Wednesday 19 July 2000.

The Exercise involves all the various response parties both on and off the site, but does not involve members of the public. An accident scenario is simulated and the organisations involved are required to respond as per the laid down procedures. The exercise in July will focus on the ability of the operators to determine the extent of offsite hazard presented by the accident and on the ability of the off site authorities to respond to requests for implementation of protective actions. The exercise will take place over a period of approximately half a day and will involve on site emergency facilities, off-site mobile monitoring vehicles and laboratories and the emergency response facilities of the local authorities concerned. The latter include civil protection control centres and mobile communication and emergency services vehicles.

The exercise will be preceded by a familiarisation programme of the various facilities and emergency centres which will take place during 17 and 18 July. A debriefing session will take place on 20 July.

I would like to extend an invitation to you to observe the exercise and to take part in the familiarisation programme and debriefing session. Should you or your representatives wish to take up this invitation, kindly inform us and further details regarding the arrangements will be provided to you.
